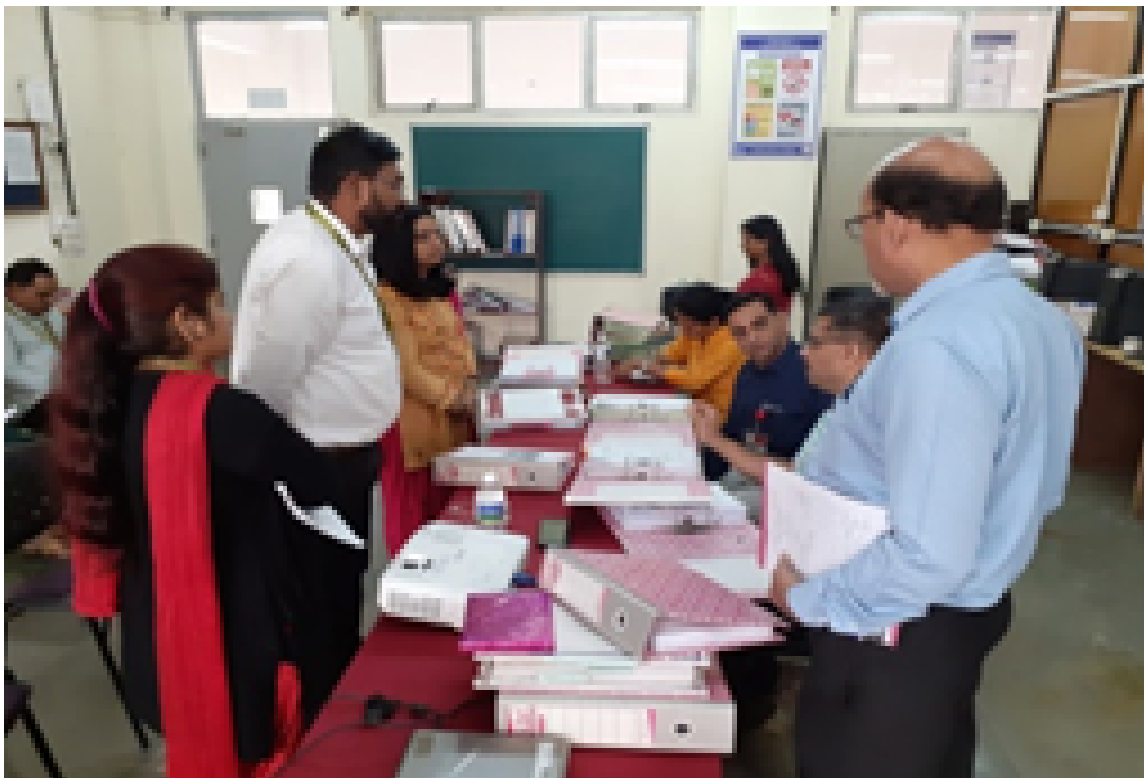

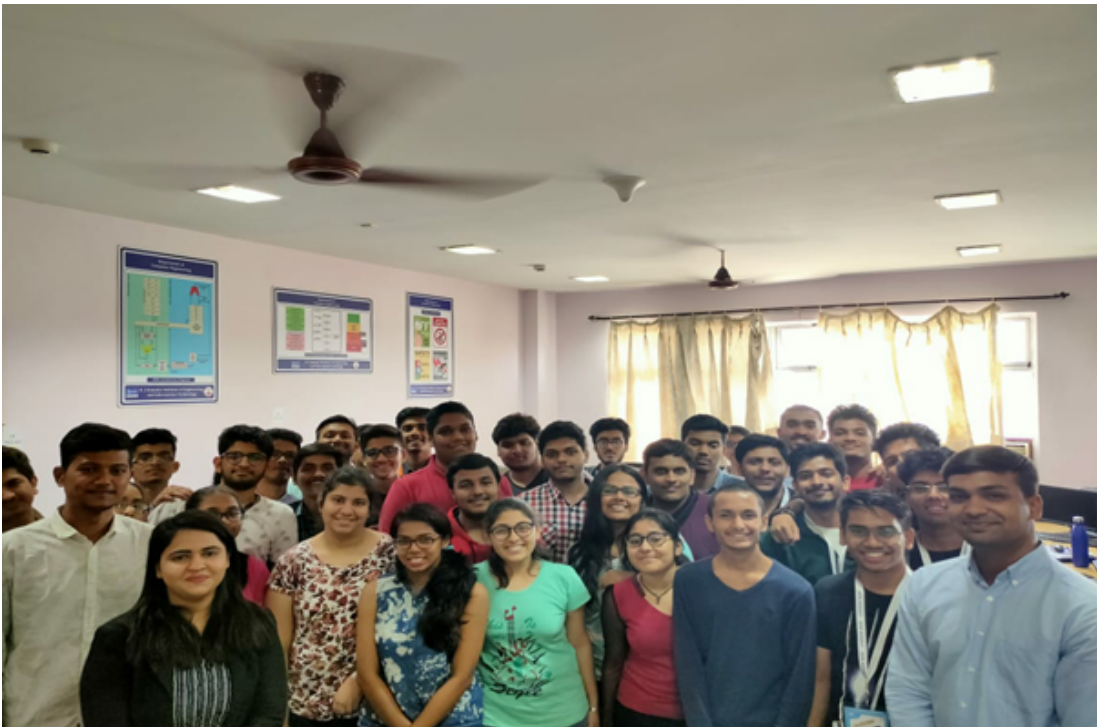
- In this academic year 2019-20, ETRX department received a Minor Research Grant from Mumbai university for 4 different projects worth Rs. 1,45,000/-.

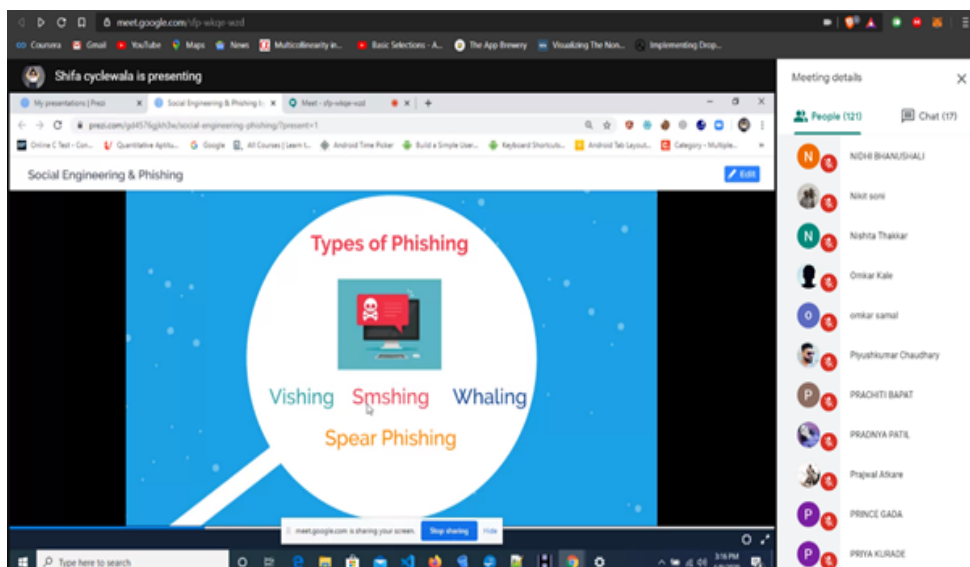
Ukarande at the onset provided his guidance to the students and appealed to the Alumni to extend their core skill expertise via Webinars, Internships to in-house students.

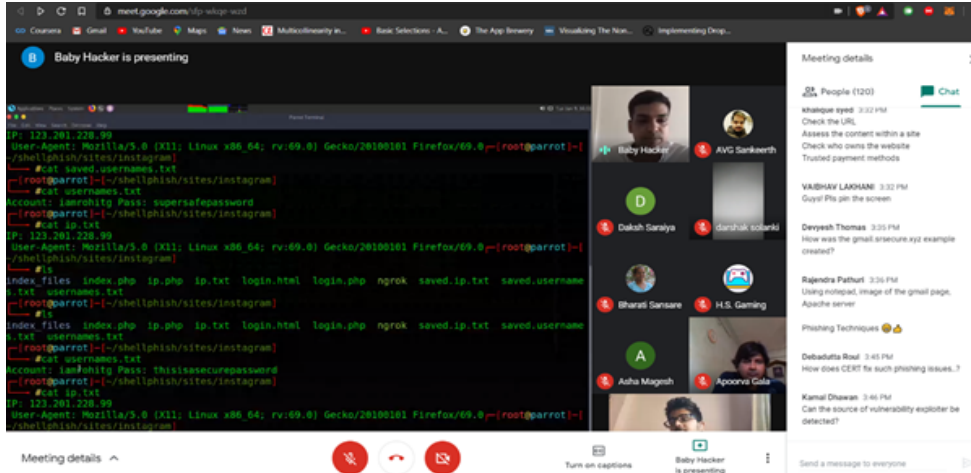

Webinar Clipping Of The Live Webinar With Alumnus—Mr. Jay Shah

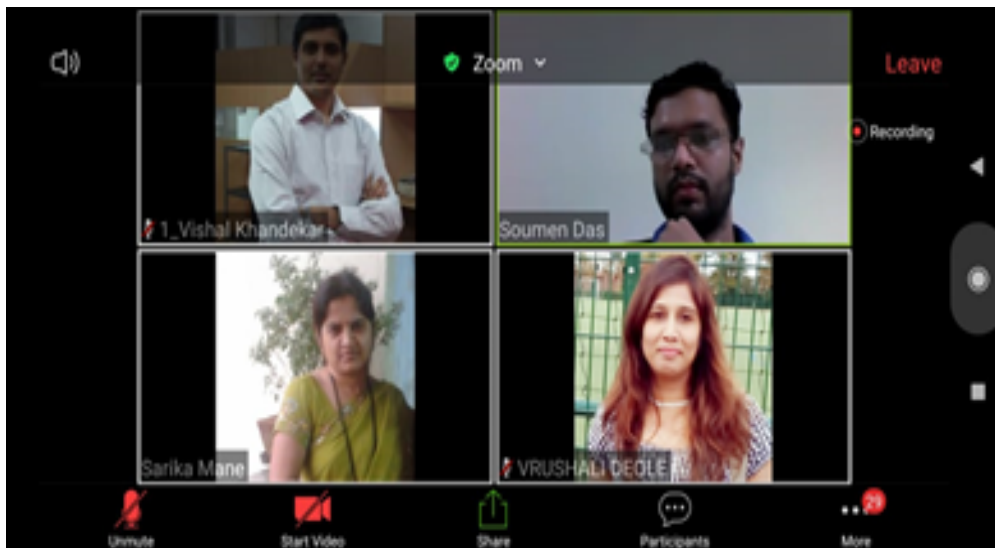
